### NEW 2008 SEM/PCA Driver's Education Harness & Seat Rules:

The South Eastern Michigan Porsche club DE Committee would like to remind all DE participants that we will be implementing the PCA Harness & Seat Rules effective January 2008.

### Rule changes mandate:

- 1. Four point systems are not allowed. You must have a FIA or SFI approved five point- or six point harness system equal restraints for both driver and passenger seat in combination with equal driver and passenger seat with integrated head restraints and holes in the seat back to guide the shoulder belt.
- 2. If you have harnesses, you must have a seat that comes from the manufacturer with the capability to, at the very least; accept the shoulder harness and the sub belt.
- You cannot modify any seat to accommodate either the shoulder harness or sub-belt.

#### **REQUIREMENTS:**

- -Helmet-Snell SA00 or newer-strictly enforced
- -Sharing of helmets will not be permitted
- -No Motorcycle Helmets
- -Minimum 3-point seat belts
- -Long sleeve cotton shirt, long cotton pants, leather or canvas shoes
- -Pre-registration

- -Please arrive at 8:00 a.m. for Track Inspections
- -Lunch is included
- -No gas will be sold at the track
- -Pre-tech car prior to track arrival with completed Tech Form. Otherwise there will be a \$50.00 charge for Tech inspection at the track. This is now enforced.
